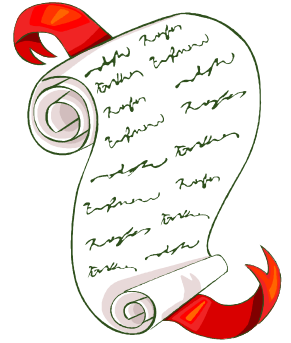

On Friday, May 11, Turner participated in the Beach Within Reach Contest in Fort Worth. This was a three-day contest held at Haltom City High School and Richland High School. Turner received 1+, 1 and 1+ ratings and was awarded "Best Band" of all beginners. They also won the "Grand Sweepstakes Award" for being the best of all Class CC 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade second and third bands. (Please understand that Waxahachie J.H. is a Class CCC school and that we were not competing against our own). Out of 60 plus bands, Turner was the only band to receive the 1+ rating. We are extremely proud of our children's accomplishments and feel that our activities and ratings have had something to do with next year's band enrollment, which is the largest over the past five years.
