- Lost cards are not replaceable, but you will get a new card each day.
- You will also have the option of utilizing the full kitchens that are available in each condo.
- Room captains/co-captains will go to the grocery store Thursday night after hotel check-in. Room captains will shop for any snack food, breakfast/lunch supplies, or other food items that their roommates would like for them to purchase for the 5 night stay in the condos. Grocery \$\$ included in cost of trip.

Food Allowance

Luggage

Please have your name/address attached

- One-suitcase (under bus), one carry on, horn (small horns on bus, large horns under bus)
- Place all luggage neatly in band hall 2 in designated lines if bringing Wednesday.
- Luggage can be dropped off at band hall 2 starting at 7:00 am, Wednesday, March 8th.
- Band hall 2 will be locked all day to protect your stuff
- Make sure you plan to have layers for the trip for cool nights and evenings. Highs in the 70's/lows in 50's.
- Make sure you have reeds, valve oil, mutes, etc.
- Bring a pencil for the workshop.
- Make sure you load your horn!
- Bring your luggage to the bus loading area...let the loading crews load onto bus cargo bay.
- Do not physically load anything into the bus cargo bay unless you are on a loading team.
- Loading Crews will load/unload all busses.

Money and Valuables

- It is your responsibility to keep up with your stuff!
- Please keep your money and your Disney Park passes with you for safety reasons. Each condo will have a safe, but be aware that the contents of the safe will be accessible by roommates.
- You may rent a locker at the parks, but I would recommend that you keep your money and passes in your possession.
- Do not leave valuable items on the busses while you are in the park or overnight. Busses can be broken in to.

Medicine

- All medicine will need to be handed to parent chaperones in the morning March 8th
- Lori McGlothlin will be in charge of collecting all medicine.
- Must have a medicine disbursement form
- Please communicate if your medicine needs to be refrigerated; if so, please bring it in a small freezer container packed with ice.
- Medication can be dropped off in band hall 2 between 7:00-8:15 am, Wednesday, March 8th.
- <u>Please drop off ALL medications BEFORE school so that we will have time to organize the medications</u> and the paperwork.
- Please turn over all medications to Lori McGlothlin (excluding inhalers or nasal sprays). This is required for several reasons:
 - 1. It is school policy
 - 2. Your child may be responsible, but your child may be sharing a room without someone that is not.
 - 3. We don't want to deal with trying to replace lost prescription medications on the trip.

<u>Medicine Disbursement while traveling:</u>

- Medicine will travel on the bus with students and chaperones will give to students.
- Once we arrive at condos assigned Chaperones for each room will be responsible for distributing medicine for their assigned students.
- Students needing medicine during the day will need to arrange a meeting time with their chaperones in the parks.
- Chaperones will have over-the-counter medicine such as ibuprofen, Tylenol, Tums, etc.

Class and Homework

It is your responsibility to get your work that you will be missing before you leave.

You're Instrumental Workshop Experience

- Wear comfortable clothing-must have shoes and shirt-do not need formal wear.
- The trip t-shirts and backpacks will be passed out in the condos.
- We will coordinate the sharing of tubas between bands.
- Only students and directors will participate in this workshop. Chaperones will go to the park.
- Bring pencils, instruments, and we will have a set of mutes if needed.
- Be serious about playing when it is time to play- be a mature musician!
- Respect the conductor and workshop technicians.
- See schedule for bus assignments for workshops.
- Guard, wear appropriate clothing to dance and spin.

Chaperones

- Our parents are here to assist and help in everyway. Please show respect at all times.
- If you have a problem with a chaperone please bring your issue to Mr. Armstrong, Mr. Bell, Mr. Jaso, or Ms. Melton rather than attempting to deal with it yourself.
- All chaperones will be assigned a group of 9-10 students that they will be accountable for during the trip.
- Students will be expected to check in every 1-2 hours via text to let their chaperones know that all is well.

General Behavior

• Violation of the district alcohol, drugs or tobacco guidelines will result in disciplinary measures as outlined in the WISD student code of conduct.

- Be respectful of your self and others.
- Do not bring air soft guns, skateboards, roller blades, or any other item that would be inappropriate.
- The band directors will handle any students requiring disciplinary actions.
- In the rare event that disciplinary action results in a student being sent home, the cost will be at the parents expense.

Bus Etiquette and Stops

- The busses will have outlets and WiFi.
- Be respectful of others!
- It will be a long trip-bring something to do (homework, books, movies)
- All movie choices must be approved by directors prior to departure from Waxahachie.
- Mr. Armstrong will determine if you are allowed to exit busses during stops. This will be determined on a stop-by-stop bases. Do not attempt to exit the busses without permission from a director.
- Please be quick and stay together.
- There will be an allotted amount of time for all food stops. Please watch the clock and be courteous to restaurant and/or store employees. We will be representing Waxahachie at ALL times.

Parks

- Use common sense
- Stay together in groups of 6 (2 does not constitute a group, this is not a couples get-away vacation)
- You will be required to load buses each evening at the designated location (park of the day). Anyone park hopping will need to make their way back to the designated park in time for loading. Please allow the necessary travel times between parks. DON'T BE LATE.
- Students need to always be accessible by cell phone. Always have access to someone with a phone.
- Want to Park Hop?
 - Groups of 6 or more must communicate with a chaperone prior to leaving one park for another.
 - A chaperone must travel to the new park with your group.
 - No chaperone....no park hopping.
- All students will receive one ticket good for all 4 days.....keep up with this ticket. (Take a pic with phone)

- Amenities
 - Complimentary WI-FI is available at the Hotel.
 - Each condo is equipped with a full kitchen: oven, microwave, stove top, refrigerator, pots, pans, and all necessary cooking utensils.
 - Washer/Dryer/Dishwasher (boosters will provide dish soap/laundry detergent)
 - 2 bed Condo-King bed, two full size beds, queen sleeper sofa
 - 3 bed Condo-King bed, four full size beds, queen sleeper sofa
- Cleanliness
 - Clean and straighten your condo each day. Keep it neat.
 - When it is time to check-out all dishes should be in the dish washer and turned on. The kitchen should be left in the same condition as check-in. You will be made to clean your condo if it does not pass check-out inspection. DO NOT TRASH THE ROOMS.
 - There will be maid service daily....keep your room organized so the maids can do their job.
- Common sense should prevail—respect all guests.
 - In the room and quiet means in the room and quiet (check daily schedule for curfew times)
 - Refrain from running around the condo.
 - Stay in groups and do not wander off.
 - Listen and respect your room chaperone.

• Hanging out in rooms.

- Male and Female students are NOT allowed in each others rooms. That includes hanging out in the door ways. Please use the hallways for mixed socialization.
- Students and Chaperones are NOT allowed to hang out in each other rooms. Students are expected to stay with other students. They are not allowed to sleep in their parents rooms regardless if the parent is chaperoning or not.
- Safety
 - Stay in room after room check unless it is a fire or medical emergency.
 - Keep door closed and locked to anyone that is not a chaperone or fellow band member.
 - Only allow your room members and/or fellow band members to enter.
 - Refrain from hanging out on balconies.
 - The pool is off limits for this trip.

• Families and Leaving Condo Property

- Students are NOT allowed to leave the hotel property for any reason. Once we are back at the hotel for the evening students are expected to stay on the hotel premises.
- Parents that will be at Disney, but that are not chaperoning, are NOT allowed to take a group of students (including their own) anywhere without approval from Mr. Armstrong.
- <u>All parents wishing to mix with the band students on this trip must have completed a district back-</u> ground check. The safety and security of our students is our highest priority on this trip.
- Family members and friends are welcome to come to the park or meet you in the lobby. You ARE NOT allowed to leave with your family members.
- Likewise, be careful cultivating "new friendships" with strangers. Do not put yourself or others at risk by being naïve.
- Students are expected to follow the WISD Code of Conduct.
